**Public Input:** Councilman DeLong reported that a citizen expressed concern about a registered sex offender now renting a place on Park Street and that there has been no notification to the area residents.

**Highway:** Rick Evans reported that the trucks are repaired and getting ready for winter. Due to being down one driver with a CDL, plow routes have been modified.

Rick Evans also reported that lots of road signs have been being stolen up on South Hill. They will need to be replaced.

The Kubota tractor that was ordered has been delayed by a couple of weeks. In the meanwhile, the older Kubota has the plow on it and should be able to handle the smaller storms that could happen in the next couple of weeks.

**Water Superintendent:** The field on Park Street has been brush-hogged.

The kiddie pool still needs repairs. Supervisor Lindberg or Councilman Miller will speak to the Water Superintendent to get this done.
