A special meeting of the Worcester Town Board was called to order at 7:00pm. The meeting opened with a salute to the flag in the municipal building located at 19 Katie Lane in Worcester.

The Town Clerk read the legal notice seeking bidders for the crushing of cobbles to make winter sand and road item. 2 bids were received:

Seward Sand and Gravel: \$10 per yard

Northern Crushing: \$6.75 per yard for 1/2” minus and \$5.25 per yard for item 4

**Resolution #63 : Awarding Crushing Bid to Northern Crushing**

Offered by Councilman Ridgeway, second by Councilman Lehenbauer: Be it resolved that the Worcester Town Board accepts and awards the crushing bid to Northern Crushing at price of \$6.75 per yard for 1/2” minus and \$5.25 per yard for item 4 with the following specifications:

Northern Crushing will furnish one Eagle 1200 Portable Crushing Plant with an operator and 50' stacker. The stacker will be equipped with a belt scale to measure crushed material. The material to be crushed is cobbles and gravel. Northern Crushing will supply all fuel required for the operation and mobilization at their expense. The material to be crushed is at the town gravel bank to the bid specification size of 1/2” minus road control and item 4 sub-base. The price is based on crushing a minimum of 6500 yards. Products produced are not certified for DOT materials. Northern Crushing will operate 8 hours a day, 5 days a week. Employees are MSHA trained and copies of the training cards are available upon request. Work to be completed by July 1, 2022. Payment will be due to Northern Crushing 30 days upon completion of the job.
