The Town Clerk read the legal notice for the public hearing on proposed the proposed highway department facility.

Scott Barton presented to the public the plan for the highway department facility to be located at the Town owned gravel bank just to the east of the Worcester Hamlet. The following items were reviewed:

- why there is a need for the facility
- what the site will look like at the property
- the cost of the project
- how the bid process will work
- the tentative timeline for the project
- heating cost savings on a new facility vs the current facility

The floor was opened for comments or questions.

Diane Addesso asked if there are any grants that can offset the cost. Supervisor Wilcox said that some are being explored. Ms. Addesso asked if there will be a project manager overseeing the whole construction process. Scott Barton explained that the town can hire a “clerk-of-the-works” and the cost associated with that is already included in the cost for the whole project.
